- You have been referred to the Stroke Clinic by the Emergency Department
- Once your referral is received, it will be triaged by the Stroke Team and booked according to the triage level. You will receive an automated message from the clinic informing you of an appointment.
- If you have not heard from the clinic within 10 business days of ED visit, please call the number listed above
- Bring all medications and your Health Card with you

Stroke Clinic Location:

- Enter at the main entrance of the hospital
- Upon entering turn left and register and you will receive directions to the offices
- Then proceed straight ahead and take the elevator down to the 1st floor
- Follow the purple line for Drs. Mattia, Sun, Maran and Yeboah to the Neurology department
- Follow the purple line but continue straight at the fire door and then follow the blue line for Dr. de Sa Boasquevisque. Have a seat in the waiting room on the right;

If you develop any acute symptoms of stroke, including the inability to speak, inability to walk, a weakness or numbness in half the body, or severe headache please call 911. You will be taken to the closest Emergency Department.

If you have any questions, please speak with the Emergency Department physician or nurse before you leave.

Your family physician is the best way to access medical care and acts as the central person in your overall healthcare. If you do not have a family doctor, we strongly advise you to find one.
